Take your beaded flowers in a new direction and learn to create three new flowers that are inside out and upside down! These delightfully different flowers are recommended for intermediate to advanced French beaded flower artists. Students must be proficient at the Round Basic, Pointed Basic, Continuous Loops, Lacing, Reverse Wrap, Beehive and Scallops. The seminar flowers will incorporate variations of all the basics and help students develop confidence in shading.

Vancouveria Hexandra

On Friday afternoon, we will start with the Vancouveria Hexandra...

also known as the Inside-Out Flower, a native to the Northwestern United States. Above the delicate, apple-green leaves rises a flower stalk



to 12". It bears an open cluster of dainty, white, inside-out flowers. Inside- out because the petals and sepals are turned abruptly backwards revealing the stamens and Pistil.



Cyclamen

We'll continue our new direction on Saturday as we create a potted Cyclamen plant. Famous for its upside down flowers, the cyclamen comes in shades of red, white, and pink. Unique leaves will make this plant a truly special addition to your collection.



Gloriosa Lily

Hang in there! Because on Sunday we make a truly spectacular Gloriosa Lily to finish our series of Upside Down Flowers. Without doubt, it is one of the most impressive of all



the Lilies with exotic deep red blooms and intriguing yellow streaks. This plant is actually a

climbing vine and tuber, one that would enhance the beauty and interest of any garden. Difficult to find in many areas of the United States, now you can have Gloriosa Lilies all year long!
